About the Projects

The Delaware County Transportation Improvement District (TID), Franklin County TID, Licking County TID, and the Ohio Department of Transportation are working together to coordinate multiple projects referred to as the Silicon Heartland County Line Projects along and around the County Line Road area, approximately 15 miles northeast of downtown Columbus. Examples of project activities being coordinated include project development, plan design, utility relocation, property acquisition, and construction.
